Address Verification in Banner using CLEAN_Address (G)Chris Eaton (Runner Technologies) CLEAN_Address verifies, standardizes and enhances postal addresses in real-time and in batch using a seamless integration in Banner. Learn how every department in an institution can benefit using CLEAN_Address including Student, Alumni, HR, and Finance.

E-COMMERCE Anyone? (T)Artis Smith (JSU) Would you like to provide your students, faculty, staff, alumni, and community members with the capability to register and pay online 24/7 for events sponsored by your school? In this session, we will discuss benefits of e-commerce and review the process for setting up a standard Universal Store (uStore) including accounting codes that map to Banner detail codes. If time permits we will discuss text messaging, social media, categories, product options, modifiers, table builder, reports, and maybe private stores. **Federal Grants Updates (F)**Louise Brown (MGCCC) Guidelines and changes for educational institutions administering federally funded grants. (Includes policy and procedures, time and effort reporting, purchasing and measurement requirements)

It will provide a semi-technical view of the file creation process, without looking at a bunch of code (but code will be available to look at if requested).
